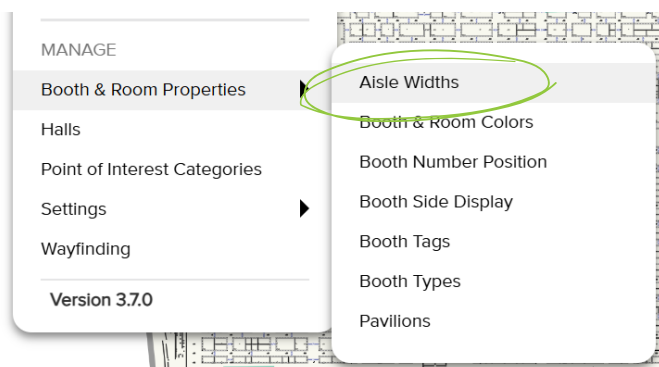
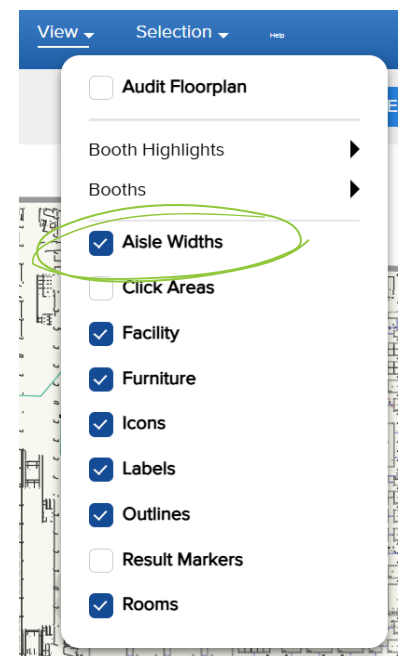


Display Aisle Widths

Keep your floor plan accurate and compliance-ready with automatically calculated aisle widths. As you place and move booths, the Builder measures the space between them in real time — displaying measurements in your event's unit of measurement (feet or meters) with no manual input required.

How it works

- 1 Toggle aisle width labels on or off**
 Each builder user can show or hide aisle width labels for their own session without affecting other users or saved settings. In the builder menu bar, go to **View** and check or uncheck **Aisle Widths**.
- 2 Configure visibility**
 Choose whether aisle width labels appear in the Builder only, or also on the exhibitor view and booth sales floor plans. When set to Builder only, measurements are a planning tool — exhibitors won't see them. Go to **File > Booth & Room Properties > Aisle Widths** and select your event's preference.

Aisle widths are visible to admins in the Builder. Each user can toggle them from **View > Aisle Widths**.

Measurements also appear on the exhibitor view and booth sales floor plans.

Update the display color

Go to **File > Booth & Room Properties > Aisle Widths** and select **Display color** to change the color used to label aisle widths on the floor plan.

Set a display threshold

To reduce clutter, set a minimum width value. Aisles narrower than this threshold are still present on the floor plan — they just won't display a label.

Display aisle widths of at least

Narrower aisles are still present — they just won't show a label.

Only aisle widths at or above this value will be labeled on the floor plan.

Go to **File > Booth & Room Properties > Aisle Widths** and set **Display aisle widths of at least**.

Set a compliance minimum for the audit

Flag any aisle narrower than a set value so it appears in the audit report as a compliance warning, making it easy to identify problem areas.

Flag in audit if aisle width is less than

Use this to flag aisles that may not meet venue requirements.

Aisles narrower than this value will appear in the audit report as a compliance warning.

Go to **File > Booth & Room Properties > Aisle Widths** and set **Flag in audit if aisle width is less than**. Be sure to **save** all changes.

Include aisle widths in a PDF export

Aisle width markings can be included when exporting your floor plan to PDF. Go to **File > Export > Export PDF** and check the box for **Aisle Widths**.

A few things to note

- Aisle widths are calculated automatically based on the space between adjacent booths and update in real time as booths are moved.
- Values display in your event's configured unit of measurement (feet for imperial events, meters for metric events).
- The aisle dimensions never display on the attendee view floor plan.
- The per-user toggle (**View > Aisle Widths**) is a personal display preference and does not affect other users.
- All other settings (**visibility, color, thresholds**) are configured under **File > Booth & Room Properties > Aisle Widths** and apply globally.
- Audit warnings can be reviewed any time under **File > View Audit Report**.
