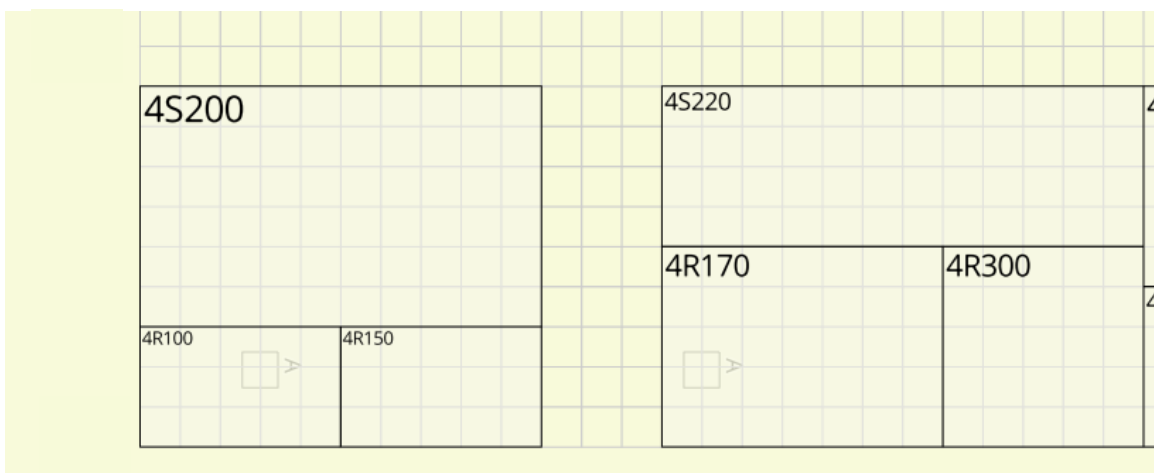


Grid Display

Many events are built around a fixed venue grid that serves as the foundation for booth placement and floor plan layout. This option allows your venue grid to be imported directly into the Builder, giving your team a consistent visual reference for placing and aligning booths accurately and efficiently.

How it works

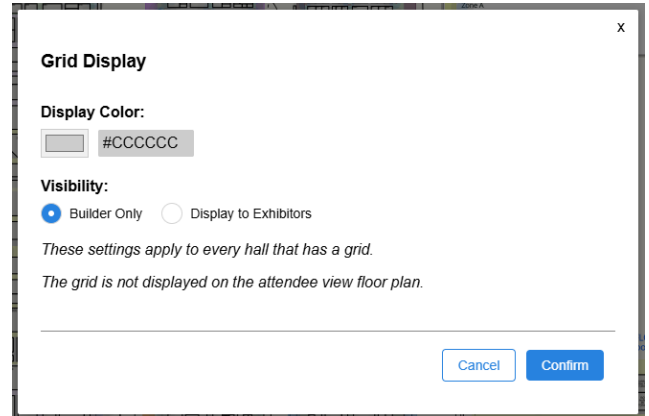
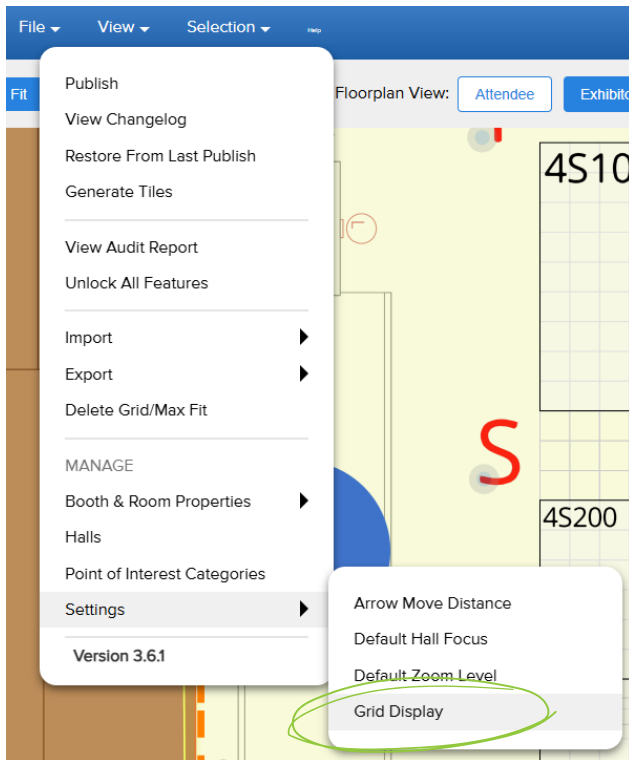
- 1 Send your DWG file to MYS**
 The grid must be on its own layer, separate from all other objects. Send the DWG file to clientsupport@mapyourshow.com.
- 2 MYS imports the grid on your behalf**
 We'll confirm once the import is complete and the grid is ready to use in Builder.
Note: This option can only be used if the hall is not using the max fit feature in MYS.
- 3 The grid appears in the Builder**
 Your team can use it as a visual guide when adding or updating booths, snapping and aligning to the grid as needed.

Adjust display settings as needed

To change the grid color or enable display on the exhibitor view floor plan, go to **File > Settings > Grid Display**.



A few things to note

- Once imported, the grid is visible in the Builder by default. Displaying it on the exhibitor view is optional and can be toggled in **Grid Display settings**.
- Each user can turn the grid layer on or off in the Builder under **View > Booths > Grid/Max Fit**.
- If your grid sizing changes between shows, **submit a new DWG file to MYS** and we'll update the import.
